

Blog Scholarships

The Board and Warden of Selwyn College are pleased to invite applications for up to three Blog Scholarships for the coming academic year.

In recent years, web logging or “blogging” has become a popular way for individuals and organisations to record events in their lives, communicate with friends and establish new relationships with readers.

Blog Scholars make an important contribution to the Selwyn College website. They not only help to maintain a healthy and well-connected community within Selwyn, but also form part of the College’s public presence.

Blog Scholars are expected to publish short weekly blog posts on the College website during term time. These posts may be in either written or photographic form; we have in mind that written posts will be a mixture of lengths, ranging from very short links and quotations to longer and more focused pieces. However, the average length of a post might be around 100 words. Photographic posts will amount to one good-quality “photo of the week”.

In recognition of their artistic and cultural contribution to College life, Blog Scholars are awarded an annual honorarium of \$1900, which is delivered as a reduction in the final two instalments of College fees. Tenure of the Scholarship is for one year, although Blog Scholars are able to re-apply in future years.

In determining the recipients of these Scholarships, preference will be given to students returning to the College for a second or third year of study. The quality of application, involvement in College life and personal circumstances of each applicant will also be taken into account.

The Board and Warden invite applications for up to three Scholarships to be awarded in one or more of the following areas:

- **Church, Theology and Music Scholarship:** Open to Selwyn students who are the children of clergy or have a connection with theology, the Anglican church, or church music.
- **Alumni Family Scholarship:** Open to Selwyn students who are from alumni families with siblings who have attended the College, particularly those with inter-generational alumni connections.
- **First Generation Scholarship:** Open to Selwyn students who are in the first generation of their family to attend University.

Applications must be received by the College Office on or before **August 7th**.
