Choral Scholars



From 2011, the University of Otago's first College will be offering choral scholarships to talented young men and women. Selwyn Choral Scholars will receive an excellent musical formation in the Anglican Choral tradition in the historic All Saints Church. Choral Scholars will receive a place in the College, a contribution towards vocal tuition from an approved singing teacher, and a scholarship of up to \$2,000 per annum. They will also provide musical leadership in the worship in All Saints church and within the College.

TASKS

- ✦ Taking part in musical activities of the College e.g. leadership in the small choir and large choir.
- ✦ Singing for services in All Saints with other choral scholars.
- ✦ Singing for services in All Saints as a cantor/soloist.
- ✦ Other musical events as may be required.



All Saints and Selwyn have a close and historic relationship. All Saints is the parish church for North Dunedin and the Selwyn College chapel.

Music at All Saints encompasses sung mass settings, hymns, anthems and motets from the 15th to 20th centuries, Gregorian chant and Taizé chant.





COMPETENCIES

- ↪ Relevant musical experience.
- ↪ Ability to organise own practice time and prepare music by oneself.
- ↪ Ability to sing different types of liturgical music appropriately.
- ↪ Ability to learn music quickly and to a high standard.
- ↪ Ability to sing as a cantor to a high standard.
- ↪ Ability to sing in a choir to a high standard.
- ↪ Ability to convincingly complete relevant application forms for residence at Selwyn College.
- ↪ Demonstrable academic and other history to indicate suitability for admission to Selwyn College.

REMUNERATION

- ↪ Choral Scholars will receive reduction in fees at the college according to the scholarship they win.
- ↪ Choral Scholars will receive a contribution towards vocal tuition from an approved teacher.
- ↪ Choral scholars will be able (within church guidelines) to use the church and church halls for individual and group recitals and rehearsals.

TIMING

- ↪ **Applications close on September 15th.**
- ↪ Choral Scholars sing on Sundays and Feast Days during semester from mid February to mid November (not all Choral Scholars will be required every Sunday).
- ↪ When on duty, Choral Scholars will be available on Sundays for the morning Mass and the Night Prayer.
